(iv) If the female candidate declares that she is pregnant before PST/PET, then a confirmatory pregnancy test to be done and in case she is found to be pregnant, irrespective of duration of pregnancy, she may be declared temporary unfit and her appointment shall be held in abeyance until the confinement is over. The vacancy against which a women candidate was selected should be kept reserved for her. She should be re-examined for PST/PET six weeks after the date of confinement, subject to the production of the medical certificate of fitness from a registered medical practitioner. If she is found fit, she may be appointed to the post kept reserved for and allow the benefits of seniority in accordance with the instructions of the Government, as amended from time to time. In case female candidate is found negative for pregnancy, she may be allowed to participate in the PST/PET."

PHYSICAL STANDARD TEST (PST)

Candidates who qualify the PET will be screened for Height, Chest (Chest measurement for male candidate only) and Weight measurements. Those who do not meet the required physical measurements as applicable will be eliminated at this stage. The candidates who are declared not qualified in physical standard i.e. height & chest (as applicable) may prefer an appeal on same day, if they so desire, to the appellate authority nominated for the centre through Presiding Officer. The decision of the Appellate Authority will be final and no further appeal or representation in this regard will be entertained thereafter. There is no provision of appeal for Physical Efficiency Test (PET).


