4. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:-

a) Age Limit & Educational Qualifications :

Age limit:- Between 20 to 25 years.

Minimum educational and other essential qualifications: - Matriculation or equivalent with diploma in Civil Engineering from an Institute recognized by the Central Government.

b) <u>Cutoff date for Age and Relaxations</u>:

- (i) A colour blind person shall not be eligible for recruitment. If at any stage of service career a person is found to be colour blind, he will be medically boarded out as per SHAPE policy in vogue in the ITBPF.
- (ii) The candidate must not have knock knee, flat foot, varicose veins or squint in eyes.
- (iii) Must be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of duties.

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(b) Tattoos: -

- iv) Candidates are not permitted to use mobile phone, calculators

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or any other electronic/electrical device. Possession of these items, whether in use or not, will be considered as "use of unfair means" in the examination and appropriate action will be taken against such candidates. Candidates who fail to submit N.O.C. at the time of documentation shall be summarily rejected.

- (vii) Domicile Certificate issued by local revenue authorities or PAN Card or Aadhar Card or Driving License or Voter Card for verification of citizenship. DETAILED MEDICAL EXAMINATION

Only those candidates who qualify in the documentation will be required to undergo Detailed Medical Examination to assess their fitness. The Detailed Medical Examination of the candidates will be conducted in terms of Uniform Guidelines for Recruitment Medical Examination for GOs and NGOs in CAPFs and AR issued vide MHA U.O. No. A.VI-1/2014-Rectt (SSB) dated 20.05.2015 and as amended from time to time by the Government.

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REVIEW MEDICAL EXAMINATION
